<b>LOCATION:</b>	Suvretta House is located in the magnificent Alpine landscape of the Upper Engadine on the Chasellas plateau in the serene Suvretta area just 10 minutes from the St Moritz train station

## GETTING THERE

- BY CAR:** The Upper Engadine is accessible via several Alpine passes. If heavy snowfall closes the passes in winter, the Engadine is still accessible through the Vereina Tunnel
- BY RAIL:** Suvretta House is accessible by International express or Intercity trains to Chur then Rhätische Bahn (RhB) to St. Moritz. Trains depart hourly. Travelling time from Zurich Main Station is around 3½ hours. A transfer service to/from St. Moritz station costs CHF 15 per person, each way
- BY AIR:** Samedan Airport is approx. 15 minutes away from the hotel by car. A flight from Zurich to St. Moritz/Samedan by private jet or charter takes 30 minutes. A transfer service to/from Samedan Airport costs CHF 90 per journey. Zurich-Kloten Airport is about three hours from St. Moritz by road. The transfer to Suvretta House in a Mercedes E-Class for one to three passengers costs CHF 800

## **FOOD & BEVERAGE**

### **THE GRAND RESTAURANT**

The Grand Restaurant is Suvretta House's formal restaurant. Head Chef Fabrizio Zanetti born, raised and trained in St Moritz has 14 GaultMillau points. His menu features French and seasonal specialities and uses fresh local produce from the market. The Grand Restaurant opens daily at 7.30 p.m. Suvretta House tradition requires gentlemen to wear a dark suit in the evenings

### **SUVRETTA STUBE**

The Suvretta Stube is the more relaxed restaurant for lunch and dinner. It serves Swiss specialities, Suvretta classics and authentic dishes from the Canton of Graubünden. The Suvretta Stube is open at lunchtime from 12noon to 3pm and in the evening from 7pm. There is no dress code

### **TEDDY CLUB**

Teddy Club is a children's restaurant serving a special children's menu. The Teddy Club is open every evening from 6:00-7:30pm trained staff are available to look after children throughout the day

### **THE HOTEL HALL**

The Hotel Hall is the heart of Suvretta House. With two roaring open fires, guests gather here at nearly any time of day or night. Tasty snacks are served all day, both indoors and out on the south-facing sun terrace. Tea and cakes are served in the afternoon and aperitifs in the evening. Next door, drinks and refreshments are served in The Club Bar. The Club Bar and Hall are open daily from 10 a.m. to midnight

### **ANTON'S BAR**

Anton's Bar commemorates the hotelier who founded Suvretta House, Anton Bon. The bar plays music for those wanting to dance the night away and is also suitable for those wanting to sit back and relax with a drink. Open daily from 10 a.m.

## **MOUNTAIN LODGE RESTAURANTS**

### **CHASELLAS**

The Chasellas restaurant sits 1,936 metres above sea-level. A casual stop for hikers and skiers at lunchtime it is more glamorous and refined in the evenings.

### **TRUTZ**

The Trutz is a mountain restaurants which belongs to Suvretta House, popular with hikers and skiers. The Trutz, 2,211 metres above sea level, serves classic home cooking and has a huge sun terrace. The restaurant is available for private hire for evening events for up to 40 people.

## **CHILDREN'S FACILITIES**

### **KIDDY CLUB AND TEDDY CLUB**

Suvretta House welcomes all ages. The Kiddy Club offers professional childcare and the Teddy Club which opens in the early evening and gives supervised children's dining

## **SPA AND WELLNESS**

The spacious health, fitness and spa area covers a total area of 1700 m<sup>2</sup>. The facilities include:

- 25-m indoor pool with panoramic view
- Outdoor whirlpool bath (36° Celsius)
- Sauna suite with Finnarium, Sanarium, Vaporium and Caldarium
- Hydro Jet massage beds
- Large gym with personal trainers
- Various massage therapies
- Body treatments and beauty therapies
- Hairdressing salon

## **BANQUET & SEMINAR ROOMS**

The newly designed boardrooms Salon Bon and Salon Segantini and the seminar rooms Salon Venise and Salon Vert are well sized for smaller events, workshops, receptions or other events

The Suvretta Conbrio banqueting suite consists of the Atrio foyer in three sections. Depending on the occasion, these rooms can be used singly or together. The Atrio is ideally suited for receptions, cocktail parties or aperitifs and just next door to the two banqueting rooms. The smaller banqueting room, Capriccio, is the appropriate size for banquets, exhibition previews and conferences for smaller groups. The spacious and elegant Festivo is in Art Deco style and seats up to 350 theatre-type chairs. For seminars, there is room for 200–350 people

## **ACTIVITIES**

### **SKIING & WINTERSPORTS**

Suvretta House has a state of the art Ski Room with 380 heated lockers. Guests can hire or buy equipment from the Ski Shop and book ski sessions directly at the hotel's Ski School. The only ski-in-ski-out resort in St. Moritz, the hotel has its own ski lift (about 100 metres from the hotel entrance). This serves the Corviglia ski slope. Other activities include snowboarding, cross-country skiing, ski touring, curling and skating

### **SUMMER SPORTS**

In the summer the Engadine offers plenty - there are many scenic hiking trails, golf courses, sailing, cycling, climbing, tennis, jogging, kite and wind surfing. Guests can also make use of the mountain railway in the summer months

### **CULTURAL EVENTS**

The Segantini Museum, the Engadine Museum, the Mili Weber House are good for those interested in local culture whilst the well-known international Polo on Snow and the White Turf on the frozen Lake St. Moritz are must-visit events. Other events include the Gourmet Festival, the Engadine Ski Marathon and the British Classic Car Meet

### **SHOPPING**

The hotel's three boutiques Vivaia, Agnola and Ermenegildo Zegna and the sports boutique offer great shopping for guests. The boutique kiosk 'il regalino' offers a small range of newspapers and magazines for daily requirements and a range of larger and smaller giftware
