- Location:** Suvretta House stands on the high plateau of Chasellas in the quiet Suvretta area, 2 kilometres west of St. Moritz in the Engadine. The Hotel enjoys a unique position with view of the Upper Engadine landscape of lakes and glorious mountains.

Getting there: By car:
The Upper Engadine is accessible via several well-developed Alpine passes. If heavy snowfall closes the passes in winter, the Engadine is readily accessible through the Vereina Tunnel.

By rail:
International express or Intercity trains to Chur; then Rhätische Bahn (RhB) to St. Moritz. Trains depart hourly. Travelling time from Zurich Main Station is around 3½ hours.
A transfer service to/from St. Moritz station costs CHF 15 per person, each way.

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By air:

Samedan Airport is about 15 minutes away from the Hotel. A flight from Zurich to St. Moritz/Samedan by private jet or charter takes 30 minutes. A transfer service to/from Samedan Airport costs CHF 90 per journey. Zurich-Kloten Airport is about three hours from St. Moritz by road. The transfer to Suvretta House in a Mercedes E-Class for one to three passengers costs CHF 800.

The basic equipment of all rooms includes: mini bar, radio, digital TV with a wide choice of cinema films, satellite on demand, direct-dial telephone with voicemail, free wireless LAN and high-speed landline Internet in all rooms and throughout the Hotel.

Gastronomy: The **GRAND RESTAURANT** is the formal restaurant at Suvretta House. Head Chef Fabrizio Zanetti seeks to please his diners with his motto 'quality is the standard - optimization is the goal.' His menu features French and seasonal specialities using produce fresh from market, and dishes appropriate to season based on natural products from the region. The Grand Restaurant

opens daily at 7.30 p.m. By Suvretta House tradition, gentlemen wear a dark suit in the evenings in the Grand Restaurant and at galas.

The **SUVRETTA STUBE** is the restaurant of choice for lunch or dinner in a relaxed atmosphere. It serves Swiss specialities, Suvretta classics and authentic dishes from the Canton of Graubünden, but interprets them in a new, light way. The Suvretta Stube is open at lunchtime from 12 a.m. to 3 p.m. and in the evening from 7 p.m. No dress code applies in the Suvretta Club.

TEDDY CLUB is the children's restaurant. Young guests eat together here and enjoy their favourite children's menus. The Teddy Club is open every evening from 6 to 7.30 p.m., while trained staff look after the children throughout the day.

Very close to the Hotel is the Restaurant **CHASELLAS** with a splendid sunny terrace. Country cooking is a popular attraction at lunchtime, while dinners are a secret tip among gourmets. In the evenings, Head Chef Robert Jagisch (15 GaultMillau points) presents varied creations based on cuisine du marché and fine Italian cuisine.

Two pleasant mountain restaurants belonging to Suvretta House are the **TRUTZ** and the **CHAMANNA**. → N.B. both restaurants cater for hikers and skiers. The Trutz, 2211 metres above sea level, serves good home cooking and offers a splendid sun terrace. The restaurant is also available for private hire for evening events for up to 40 people.

The **CHAMANNA** mountain restaurant is only open in the winter season. A plain hut, it is renowned for pan-fried dishes of the day and traditional raclette. On sunny days, there is room on the terrace for around 120 diners. The restaurant, with table service, seats just under 140.

Hotel hall
and bars:

The **HOTEL HALL** with two open fires is the warm heart of Suvretta House. Guests gather here at nearly any time of day or night. Tasty snacks are served all day, both indoors here and on the south-facing, spacious **SUN TERRACE**. Tea and cakes are served in the afternoon; aperitifs in the evening. Inviting armchairs, a tile oven radiating homely warmth and a crackling fire in the hearth room: the **SUVRETTA CLUB** hall offers guests a friendly and informal atmosphere. Next door, drinks and refreshments are served in the **CLUB BAR**. The club hall and bar are open daily from 10 a.m. to midnight.

ANTON'S BAR is the rendezvous before each dinner, a venue for refined entertainment and relaxation. The name commemorates the hotelier who founded Suvretta House, Anton Bon. This is the place for music with a beat, and couples who dance into the night, or guests who just want to sit back over a drink. Open daily from 10 a.m.

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A House for children:

Families are welcome at Suvretta House. The younger generation are looked after by professionals in their own **KIDDY CLUB**. The children actually have their own restaurant, the **TEDDY CLUB** which opens in the early evening, so that their parents can dine quietly for once and in style, by themselves or with friends.

Wellness & Spa:

The spacious health, fitness and spa area **SUVRETTA SPORTS & PLEASURE** covers a total area of 1700 m². The facilities comprise:

- 25-m indoor pool with panoramic view
- Outdoor whirlpool bath (36° Celsius)
- Sauna suite with Finnarium, Sanarium, Vaporium and Caldarium
- Hydrojet massage beds
- Large gym with personal trainers
- Various massage therapies
- Body treatments and facials (beauty)
- Hairdressing salon

Meeting & Seminar rooms:

The newly designed boardrooms **SALON BON** and **SALON SEGANTINI** and the seminar rooms **SALON VENISE** and **SALON VERT** are just the right size for smaller events, workshops, receptions or other events.

ConBrio:

The banqueting suite **SUVRETTA CONBRIO** consists of the Atrio foyer in three sections. Depending on the occasion, the banqueting rooms can be used singly or together. The **ATRIO** is ideally suited for receptions, cocktail parties or aperitifs and just next door to the two banqueting rooms. The smaller banqueting room, **CAPRICCIO**, is the appropriate size for banquets, exhibition previews and conferences for smaller groups. The spacious and elegant **FESTIVO** is in Art Deco style and seats up to 350 theatre-type chairs. For seminars, there is room for 200–350 people, depending on the seating used.

Skiing:

Suvretta House has a modern Ski Room with 380 heated store cupboards. Guests can hire or buy the latest equipment in the Ski Shop. Guests book their ski sessions direct at the Ski School sales desk, which is part of the Hotel. Winter sportspeople eager to get going have direct access to the Hotel's own trainer ski lift, about 100 metres from the Hotel entrance. This serves the Corviglia ski slope. In the winter season 2015-16, guests staying for two nights or more can travel on all the mountain railways and public transport of the Upper Engadine at the special fare of CHF 35 per person per overnight stay (valid throughout the length of their stay).

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Recreation &
sports:

In summer, the Engadine offers unrivalled leisure facilities and an inclusive offer for the mountain railway. From two nights, the ticket for the mountain railway and public transport is included in the room rate. Examples of the recreational facilities are the many kilometres of hiking trails, golf, wind- and kitesurfing, cycling, climbing and jogging. In winter the Engadine is the destination of choice for skiing, snowboarding, cross-country skiing, ski touring, curling and skating.

Cultural
provision &
events:

The Segantini Museum, the Engadine Museum, the Mili Weber House and the well-known international Polo on Snow and the White Turf on the frozen Lake St. Moritz. Other events include the Gourmet Festival, the Engadine Ski Marathon and the British Classic Car Meeting.

Shopping:

The three boutiques Vivaia, Agnona and Ermenegildo Zegna and the sports boutique are opportunities for fashionable shopping inside Suvretta House. The boutique kiosk 'il regalino' offers a small range of newspapers and magazines for daily requirements and a range of larger and smaller giftware.

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
